Dear Park Neighbor,

We would like to inform you that the Krejci Dump Site clean-up is scheduled to commence on Wednesday, September 14, 2005. The Site is located adjacent to Hines Hill Road in Cuyahoga Valley National Park, Ohio, and is divided into two portions (the West and East sites) by I-271. The cleanup, known as the remedial action, will remove from the Site all debris and soils containing unacceptable levels of contaminants pursuant to the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), also known as Superfund.

For the first two weeks, work will consist of preparing the support zone, trailer mobilization, setting up utilities, surveying and construction of soil erosion control features. Significant off-site truck traffic will not commence until mid-October.
