Following are the top five Public Health programs utilized by **BOSTON HEIGHTS VILLAGE** residents in 2013, based on the number of service hours provided.

- 1. Home Sewage Program-** This program provides inspection, evaluation and permitting for the installation, replacement, repair and abandonment of home sewage treatment systems (HSTS), as well as monitoring of discharging HSTS. This program is also responsible for point of sale inspections, liquid waste hauler registration and inspection, and storm water quality monitoring.
- 2. Mosquito Control-** The goal of this program is to provide an efficient, economical, and environmentally-conscious program of mosquito control to reduce populations of possible disease carrying vectors, as well as the incidence and/or the potential of human disease as a result of contact with mosquitoes.
- 3. Food Safety -** The goal of the food safety program is to investigate reports of food-borne illnesses and to reduce the potential for food-borne disease outbreaks. The Food Safety Program licenses, regulates and inspects all food service operations and retail establishments including restaurants, grocery stores, mobile, temporary, and vending operations to ensure that all comply with the applicable laws.
- 4. Swimming Pools/Spas -** A goal of this program is to minimize safety hazards and reduce the potential for disease transmission and ensure that swimming pools and spas are operated, and maintained in compliance with applicable laws and rules.
- 5. Housing Complaints -** Sanitarians in this program investigate complaint generated issues involving landlord/tenant repair, vacant, dilapidated homes, insect/animal nuisances, and garbage/trash and other solid waste nuisances.
