AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 3-2011 TO ESTABLISH PAY RATE AND SCHEDULE FOR THE NEWLY ESTABLISHED POSITION OF FISCAL OFFICER FOR THE VILLAGE OF BOSTON HEIGHTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Boston Heights, Ohio as follows:

<u>Section 1:</u> That Ordinance 3-2011 shall be amended retroactively with an effective date of April 1, 2012 and that Sub-Section H of Section 4 of Ordinance 3-2011, also known as the Pay Ordinance, shall be created and state as follows:

## H. Fiscal Officer

The pay rate for the position of Fiscal Officer of the Village of Boston Heights, Ohio shall be \$18.77 per hour.

<u>Section 2:</u> That this Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council which resulted in formal action were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with the applicable legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3:</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and to allow for the continued operations of the Village departments and shall therefore take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage.
