ORDINANCE 2016-10-15 (Second Reading)

Ed. Note: This is an amended version of a previously-discussed measure to consolidate the penalties for violating the Zoning Code. A previous public hearing had persuaded Council to send the matter back to the Planning Commission to reconsider the enforcement of the Timbering regulations. The PC did so, and modified the changes to the Timbering regulations to clarify the penalties for violation, as well as clarifying the handling of unpaid fines.

Note: This change to the Zoning Code would update the review of developments to "private recreation areas" (like the Ledgeview Girl Scout Camp) to be handled by the Planning Commission, like all other areas of the Village, rather than the BZA. It also clarifies that such areas are subject to the usual review and enforcement provisions of the Zoning Code.
