A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO TREASURER JOSH MANDEL'S OHIO CHECKBOOK WEBSITE PROGRAM

Editor's Note: This resolution authorizes the Village's Fiscal Officer Betty Klingenberg to set up the Village's participation in the State of Ohio Treasurer's "Ohio's Online Checkbook" program. RESOLUTION 2017-9-25 (First Reading)

A RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO RENEW THE TAX LEVY AT THE TAX RATE OF .75 MILLS AND REQUESTING THE SUMMIT COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER TO CERTIFY THE TOTAL CURRENT TAX VALUATION OF THE VILLAGE AND THE DOLLAR AMOUNT OF REVENUE THAT WOULD BE GENERATED BY THIS RENEWAL LEVY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Editor's Note: This resolution begins the process of putting one of the Village's two fire protection levies on the ballot for renewal.

This is the larger of the two levies, a three-year levy allocated toward *operation* of the fire protection service (currently through Valley Fire District). It was last renewed in November 2014, 68%-32%.

Note that only renewal levies are now still eligible for reduced taxation rates through the state's homeowner reduction copayments. New levies would impose the entire millage directly on the local taxpayers.
