ED. NOTE: This is the 2nd stage of the process that enables the Village to put onto the (May?) ballot a renewal of the Village’s 0.75 mill / 3 year Fire Levy for operating purposes, last renewed in Nov’15. This is not the capital Fire Levy (0.5 mills / 5 years), which applies to equipment, vehicles, and fire station. That other levy was renewed in Nov’14. Both Fire Levies partially pay for the Village’s contract with Valley Fire District for firefighting and ambulance services; the balance is paid from the General Fund.
