ORDINANCE 2020-12-27 (Third Reading)

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE IMPROVEMENTS TO CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE TO BE A PUBLIC PURPOSE; DESCRIBING THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS TO BE MADE TO DIRECTLY BENEFIT SUCH PARCELS; EXEMPTING SUCH PARCELS; EXEMPTING SUCH IMPROVEMENTS FROM AD VALOREM REAL PROPERTY TAXATION; REQUIRING THE OWNER OF THE IMPROVEMENTS TO MAKE SERVICE PAYMENTS IN LIEU OF AD VALOREM REAL PROPERTY TAXES AND ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL IMPROVEMENT TAX INCREMENT EQUIVALENT FUND FOR THE DEPOSIT OF THE SERVICE PAYMENTS IN LIEU OF AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES, ALL PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 5709.40, 5709.42, AND 5709.43 OF THE REVISED CODE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

ED.NOTE: This appears to be the first step is setting up Tax Increment Financing (TIF) for the 58A property recently approved for use as a "delivery station" at Hines Hill Road and Dean Memorial Parkway. There has still been no official statement or announcement on the identity of the company that will operate hundreds of delivery vans from the site. At a recent meeting, the Solicitor explained that this TIF is not exactly a property tax abatement, in that the same amounts will be paid by the property owner, but earmarked by the Village for compensation to the Hudson School District and for improvements to the immediate surrounding area of the Village.
